NOW FOR SOMETHING THAT REALLY CONCERNS US

In view of some services for children with ME still apparently "prescribing" Graded Exercise "rehabilitation", we thought we would remind you that the new NICE Guideline (2021) clearly states: "Do not offer [...] any therapy based on physical activity or exercise as a cure" or "any programme that [...] uses fixed incremental increases in physical activity or exercise, for example, Graded Exercise Therapy." We would strongly agree as we have found that as the body recovers it is able to do more, not the other way around.



We have been shocked to hear of families still

suffering child protection investigations when they decline these therapies or when the child does not recover as a result of them. I've even heard of some being told that they can't use a wheelchair to get about any more.
